Rally rides will be scheduled in sessions at 9:00am, 10:30am, 12:30pm, 2:00pm and 3:30pm on Sunday 10 August 2014.

What to Bring?

Rides Day participants should wear long pants and long sleeves, with closed in shoes. Long sleeved BORMSA t-shirts will be available for sale on the day. Friends and family are encouraged to attend and bring a camera to record your rally ride.

How Old Do I Need to Be?

Passengers must be at least 14 years old.

What Will Be Provided?

Turbocharged 4WD rally cars complete with roll cages, race seats, harnesses and experienced drivers shall be provided.

All passengers shall be fitted with a helmet and will need to sign the CAMS "Passenger in Vehicle" disclaimer prior to participating.

What If It's Raining?

The Rally Rides day will still proceed in the rain. If the weather is such that the track is too dangerous, the Rides Day will be rescheduled or refunds offered.

Who Will Be Driving?

Regular **rallyschool.com.au** instructors will be driving the cars. All drivers are widely experienced rally competitors in the WA, national or international rally communities.

What If I Want To Drive?

The Rally Rides Day at **BORMSA** is for passenger rides only. **Rallyschool.com.au** operate regularly at Bakers Hill (WA) and offer a range of courses including 2-Car 16 Lap Attack, XLR-8 Pack, ½ Day Extreme Driving and Ultimate Full Day Driving.

Alternatively, if you would like to compete in an entry level environment, buy a car and join BORMSA! Club members will be available on the day to discuss what is involved.

Where is BORMSA?
